## FSN2023 - Arrival Instructions & Guidelines

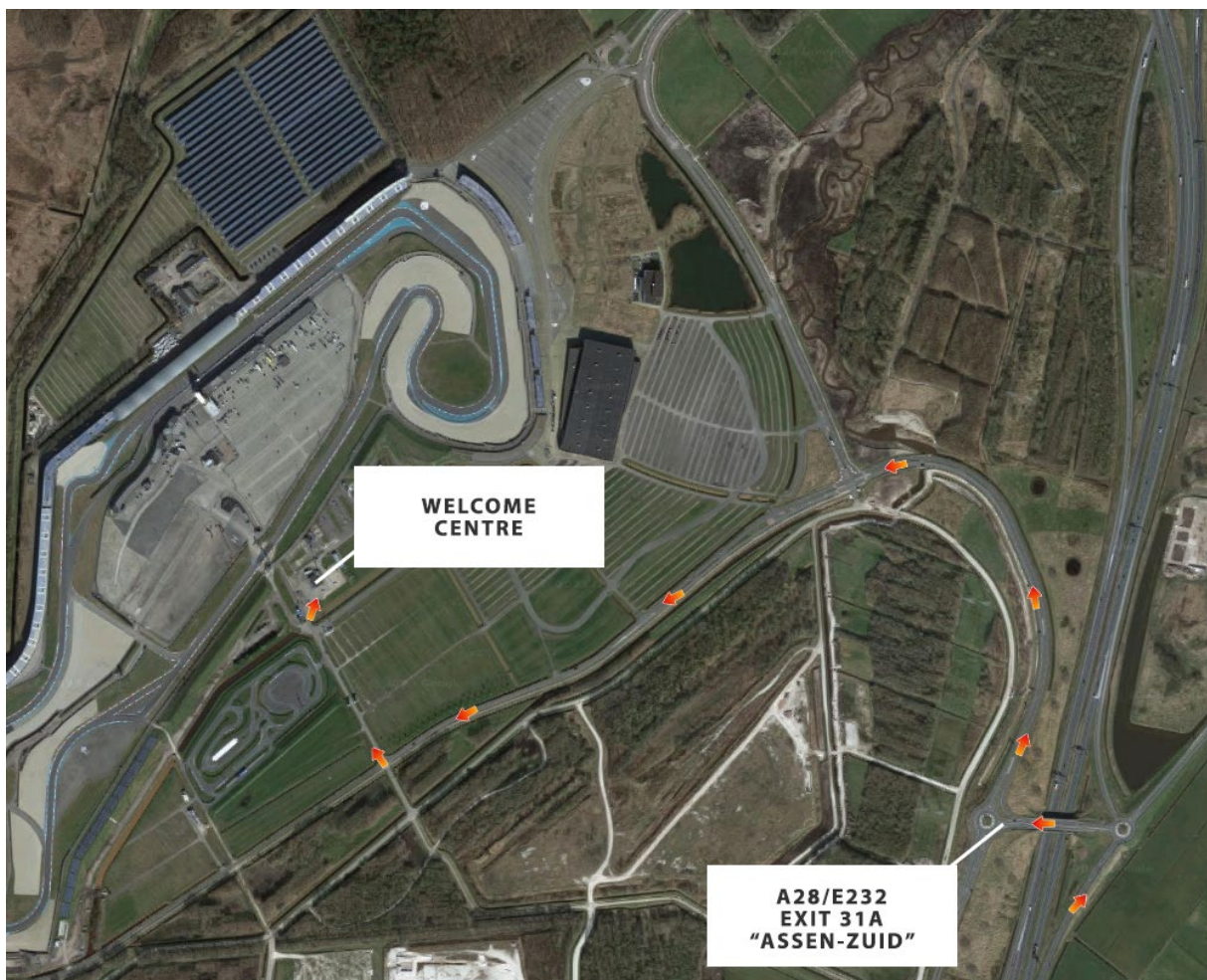
The TT Circuit is an international venue with plenty of activity throughout the season. As FSN is hosted in the middle of high season, we share the venue with other series and promoters. Therefore, certain areas are restricted during arrival times. Please follow the instructions below to ensure a smooth arrival process.

### STEP 1: Go to the Welcome Centre

**Upon arrival, a team should first go to the Welcome Centre – not to the campsite!!**

Exit the A28 highway at exit 31a “Assen-Zuid” and follow the signs for the TT Circuit. Find the Welcome Centre on your right hand side, just before entering the paddock.

In the welcome centre, you will be asked to register the team, this can be done by the team manager or deputy team manager. Officials will guide you from the Welcome Centre to your designated spot on the campsite.

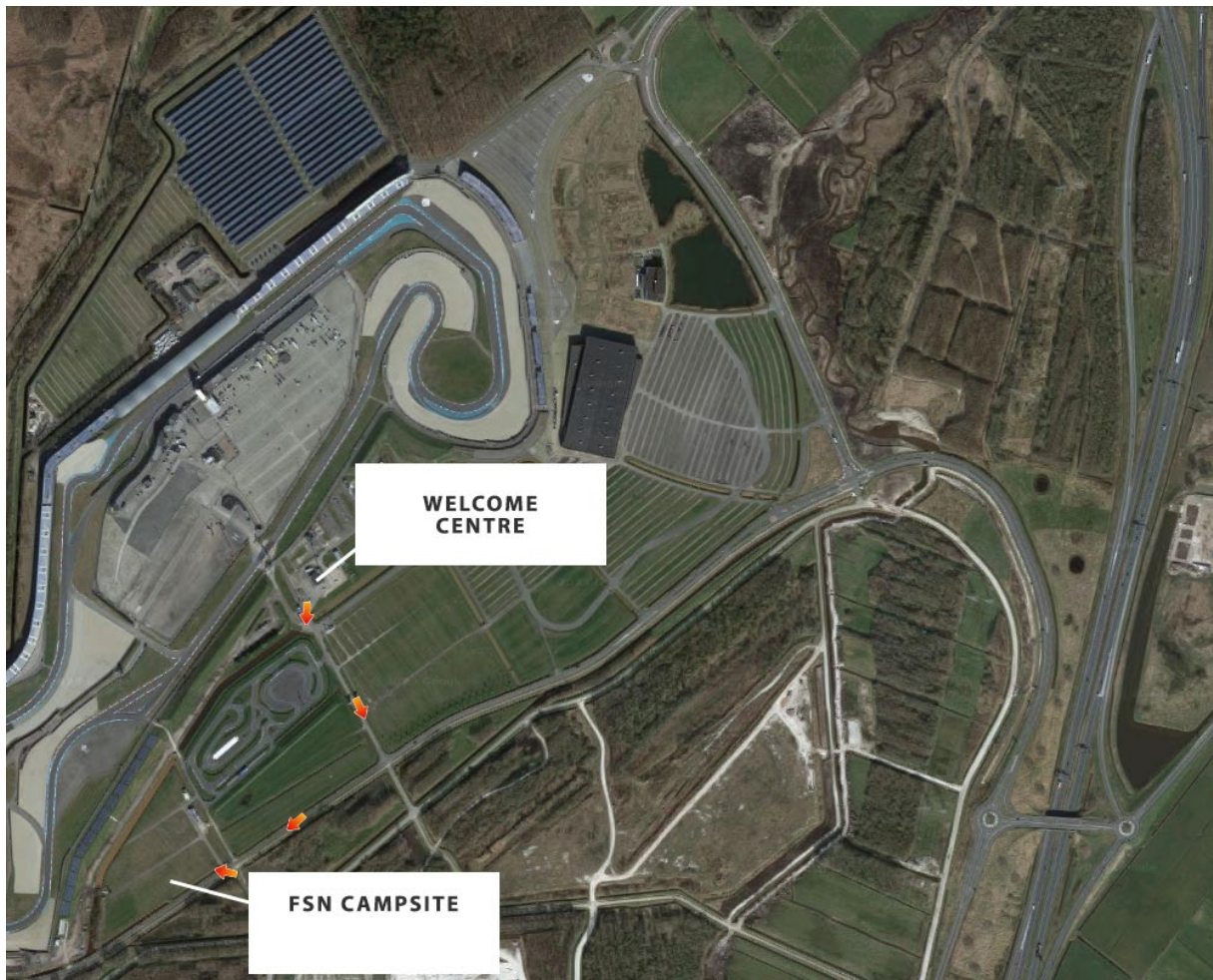

## STEP 2: Go to the Campsite

Officials will guide you to the campsite. Please wait kindly for officials to guide you there as space is limited. **Vehicles are only allowed on the campsite for loading/unloading during construction.**

Throughout the event week, you must use the adjacent car park. No vehicles will be allowed on the campsite during the event period.

### STEP 3: Park your vehicles

After setting up your camp and unloading your vehicles, you must move cars and light vehicles to the car park. Heavier trucks and trailers must be moved to a secured parking lot.

It is advised that you also store your FS-vehicle in a truck or trailer on the secure parking lot. **Working on the car is NOT allowed on the campsite or in the secure parking lot.**

Working on the car is defined as;

- Anything action that involves power tools and/or;
- Anything action that involves the tractive system

What is allowed?

- Assembling front wings with manual tools
- Placing stickers on the car
- Cleaning the car

**EV Class only: All accumulator containers must be stored in a truck or trailer on the secured parking lot. No accumulators are allowed on the campsite.**
