The present document explains the general operation and the procedure that will be followed for queue management for the Endurance Event in Formula Student Netherlands 2025.

Running Order

The running order of the teams will be determined by the results of the Autocross Event.

Queue Management Policy

The teams are responsible to be present in the Endurance Event Area during the event and always be aware of the queue as it evolves. This can be done on site through the board in which track conditions, announcements and the queue will be updated (located in front of the Pre Inspection area). The queue will be handled as follows:

The teams that should enter the Pre Inspection area shall line up in the Queue for Inspection (yellow area in the map) as will be instructed by Officials on site **in a ready to race condition**.

When called upon, a team has 5 minutes to enter the Pre Inspection area or their spot will be lost. When a spot is lost, the team is moved to the end of the queue and can compete again after all the remaining teams have either competed or lost their spot. (See below)

Penalties for Running Out-of-order (OOO) will be applied to teams missing their Ready-by Time. For each subsequent missing of the slot, a penalty of 10 points will be applied.

Endurance Dynamic Area

Every team can have 2 members and two drivers (total of 4 members) inside the Dynamic Area. The people can switch their orange dynamic vests if desired. Switching vests is only allowed outside the Dynamic Area.

Toolboxes and Tires

Due to safety standards and limited space, it is not allowed to enter the dynamic area with big, wheeled tool

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boxes. Hand held, small tool boxes containing only the necessary tools are allowed, as well as tires if needed.

Post Inspection and Penalties

Penalties gathered in post inspection and any other penalties, will be announced after the Endurance event. If a team passed post inspection and is let go from the post inspection area it does not mean that they have received no penalties. Penalties will be announced before the closing ceremony.

General Conduct

A general professional and mature behavior is expected inside the Dynamic Area. Running will lead to a 20-point penalty
